



What Would Jesus Undo: wk1 Spiritual Indifference

Introduction: Often we begin a new year by trying new things or considering what we should add to improve. But what if we asked ourselves if there are things that we do or in who we have become that Jesus would like to undo? Then how do we give him permission to undo that in us?

Discussion Questions

1. Do you remember the WWJD bracelets? Did you have one? What was good and not so good about that bracelet idea?
2. Have you ever been excited to give a gift and the receiver didn't act nearly as excited as you hoped? What is that like? If you think about the gifts that Jesus gives us-what can you name? Is there still any excitement about those things?
3. **Read Revelation 3:15-17** When Jesus says he wishes they were one or the other, what does he mean? This letter was written to a church, not non-Christians; what would cause a church to be "spit" out of Jesus' mouth?
4. Jesus tells them that they don't realize they are poor. How can self-sufficiency lead us to spiritual indifference? What is something that you need God for daily?
5. Read Revelation 3:19-20 What is the call and invitation of Jesus to his church in Revelation? Do you think that call is the same or different today? How can you respond to that call?
6. What is something that you can do or already do, that stretches your faith daily? What happens if you don't stretch your faith regularly?
