- 3. Read **John 6:11-13;23** Why would Jesus give thanks for provision that seemed too little? Why do you think John mentions Jesus giving thanks in his description of the place in verse 23?
- 4. Why is it important to recognize God's provision even in difficult circumstances? Can you recall a difficult situation in your life where you recognized God's provision? How did it affect your faith and thankfulness?
- 5. Read John 11:41-42 Jesus thanks God for hearing him. What does it say to you that God hears your prayers? Do you ever wonder if that's true? If it is is that reason for thankfulness?
- 6. In what ways can you practice gratitude every day, and how do you think it will impact your relationship with God?
