- 5. What is the significance of the curtain in the Temple being torn in two from the top to bottom? What do you make of Matthew telling us about holy people being resurrected and seen in the city after Jesus' resurrection?
- 6. How is the resurrection the foundation of our faith? Why is that (whether Jesus rose again or didn't) the place to start when examining Christianity?
