### Discussion Questions

1. Do you have a saying that you remember your mom saying, or you have used it as an adult?
2. Read **Luke 11:27-28** Does anything about Jesus reply to the praise of his mother surprise you? While being a parent is a high calling, what would Jesus say is the highest calling?
3. What lessons can we learn from Eve? When scripture says sin entered the world, who is referenced Adam or Eve? Why do you think Eve is often portrayed negatively?
4. Read **1 Kings 17:9-16** This woman was not from Israel, yet she listened to the prophet from there. Put yourself in her shoes, how difficult would it be to feed him first? We are told that her supplies didn't run out – but she doesn't get a big shipment or see more – just that it doesn't run out. How difficult would it be to face that same test every day?
5. What can we learn about giving from the Widow of Zarephath?
6. There were 4 mothers mentioned in the sermon (Eve, Hannah, Widow of Zarephath, Mary). Which one resonates with you the most and why?
